Kansas Supreme Court Rule 106(d)(4) grants authority to the Chief Judge to determine the manner in which this district shall close existing marriage licensing documents. The court finds that the interests of the court and its patrons are best served if all marriage licenses are treated the same. When the clerk receives a request for disclosure or for a copy of marriage licensing documents created before October 1, 2015, the clerk shall redact such documents in such manner that the documents disclosed or furnished contain only that information contained in uniform marriage license applications created after October 1, 2015, and must not include an applicant's Social Security number, date or city of birth, mother's maiden name, or any information expressly designated as confidential on forms promulgated by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment under K.S.A. 23-2509.
