

Douglas County Domestic Mediation Services is seeking to add two mediators to its program. As part of the program, mediators agree to accept cases on a rotating basis; mediation fees are reduced and based upon a sliding scale where each party pays according to their individual income. The program contemplates a total of four hours of mediation for each case. Local court rule requires parties to a contested case involving child custody, parenting schedules and/or parenting rights to attempt mediation prior to setting the case for final hearing. The issue most often mediated in the program is parenting time. Domestic Mediators approved by the Kansas Supreme Court for the 7th Judicial District may apply by submitting a resume by June 14, 2019, to Katy Nitcher, District Court Trustee, knitcher@douglascountyks.org.
